

January 2012 Conference - Session Guide

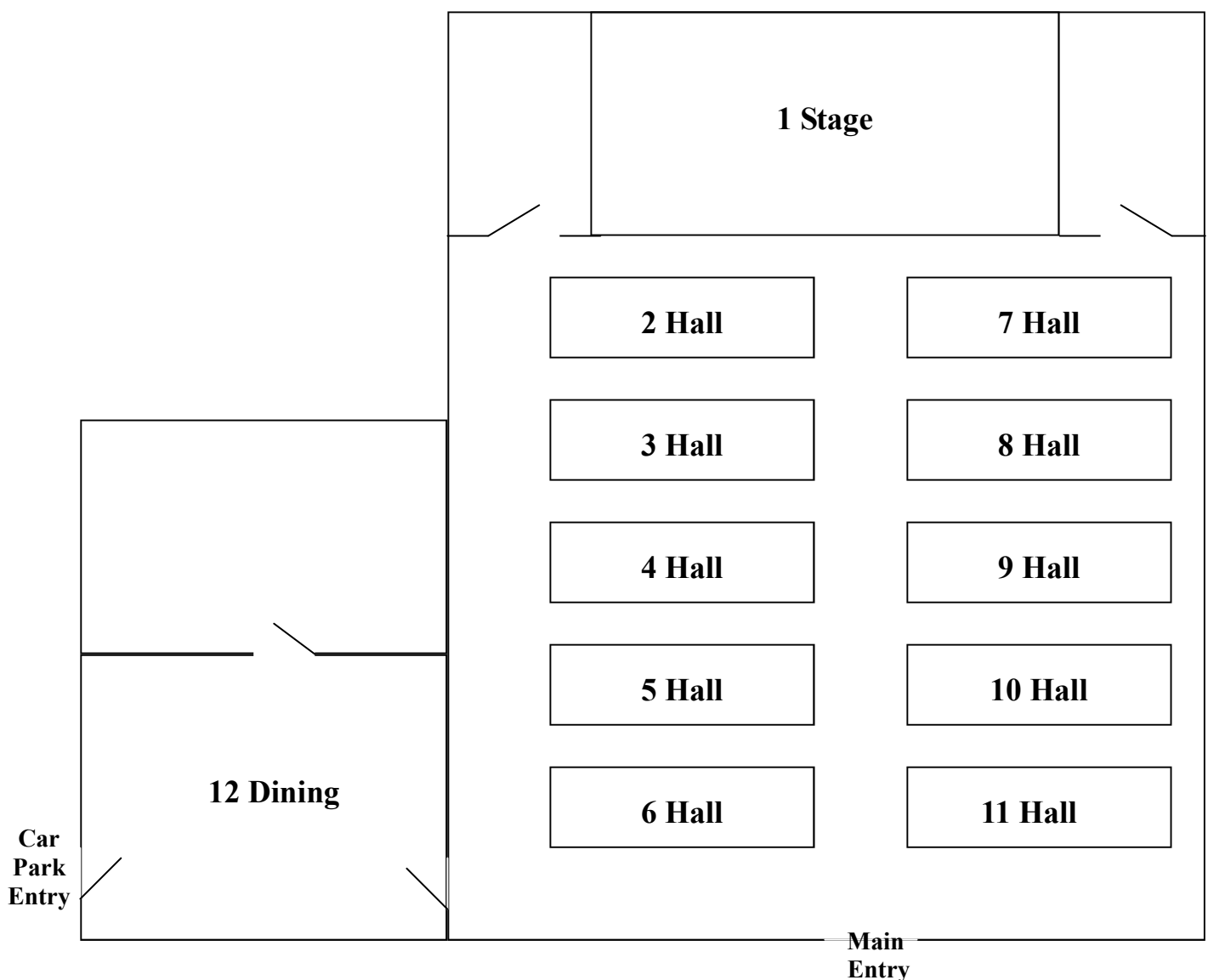
